Ranking in University

The college prepares the students to achieve excellence in various fields so that they can face local to global challenges. The college provides best learning environment and a lot of opportunities to excel in their career. During the AQAR reporting year of 2021-22 Sandeep Tyagi secured 5th rank in MSc Agronomy, Atul Kumar Mishra got 5th rank in MSc Horticulture, Shilpi Saini got 1st position in MSc Agriculture Chemistry and Neha got 3rd position in B.Com in C.C.S. University Meerut. During session 2020-21, Jaspreet Kaur and Shivam Gupta, secured 1st, and 5th positions in MSc (Ag) Horticulture and Raushan Kumar, Sanjay Kumar and Akash Babu secured 1st, 3rd and 4th rank in M.Sc Ag. Chemistry and soil science Degree programme, while, Tripati Goyal and Sidhant Tomar got 1st and 2nd positions in BSc (Ag) degree programme of C.C.S. University ranking list, respectively. During 2019-20 also, many students had secured high ranking in the CCS University's Merit Rank. Mr. Mukesh Kumar Sharma, Gaurav Sharma, Ram Swaroop Jaat and Narendra Kumar secured 1st, 3rd, 4th and 5th positions in MSc (Ag) Ag. Certificate Courses

New Courses

Training and Placement cell



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College has separate Training and Placement cell for students support and guidance which helps in choosing their career after graduation and Post-graduation. The cell invites corporate executives/CEO for campus placement. Till now a large number of students get job in different multinational companies under the guidance of training and placement cell. Guest lectures are arranged to provide guidance about career options and personality development. Besides providing the best possible teaching learning environment from the available resources, the future fit students are being prepared by exposing them to various co-curricular/extra-curricular activities. Sports and Physical Activities

The college has organized various indoor and outdoor sport activities in campus. These activities include Badminton, Chess, Javelin throw, Short Put, Long Jump and Triple jump. Extra Co curricular Activities

College has well established NCC, NSS and Rover Ranger Units. NSS Seven day's Day camp on relevant themes is also being organized each year. Agri skill Centre for self-employment training and research (ASSET)

For developing the self-employment and Entrepreneurship skills among the students, ‘ASSET’ (Agri skill Centre for self-employment training and research) is functional in the college premises with the objective of creation of self-employment, transfer of technology and development of entrepreneurship skill. It is helping the students in taking the hands-on training in different arena such as organic farming, dairy farming, bio-gas operation



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integrated with pisciculture, NADEP compost technique, vermi-composting, apiculture, poultry farming, fodder production through hydroponics and mushroom farming. During the study period, the students got the expertise so that they may be self-reliant and or/create jobs. The farmers of the vicinity are also benefited by this adventure. The problems of the farmer have also been solved by the respective faculty member. Kisan Gosthies are also conducted in order to highlight the burning issues related to agriculture and its remedy. The on-study students collect the problems of farmers and techniques used by them during the Rural Agriculture Work Experience (RAWE) programme which run for a semester. The farmers are encouraged to take the problems to college platform for redressal purpose by the RAWE students. Any farmer can visit the Centre to learn the technique and get the solution of their problem. College also has Soil Testing Facility for analysing the soils and water samples of farmers helps in judicious use of nutrients in order to overcome the problem of soil and ground water pollution.
